What's New?



### HBIIP – What's New?

- Quarterly competitions with \$90 million available each quarter.
- Make available approximately \$68.5 million to transportation fueling facility applicants,
   \$18 million to fuel distribution facilities, and \$4.5 million to home heating oil distribution facilities.
- Add home heating oil distribution facility as applicant type under Fuel Distribution Facility applicant type.
- Increase Federal cost share for eligible activities to 75 percent for transportation fueling facilities owning 10 or fewer stations and home heating oil distribution facilities.
- Updated capped costs for fuel dispensers and fuel storage tanks for transportation fueling facility applicants.



## Overview



#### **HBIIP Overview**

Of the **\$90 million** available to eligible participants/owners each quarter:

 Approximately \$68.5 million is available to <u>transportation</u> <u>fueling facilities</u>,

for activities related to higher blends of fuel ethanol, greater than 10 percent ethanol, including E15 and E85, and biodiesel greater than 5 percent biodiesel, including B20 or higher.

## Transportation fueling facilities include:

Fueling stations, convenience stores, hypermarket fueling stations, fleet facilities, and similar entities with capital investments.

## HBIIP Overview (continued)

#### **Eligible Project Costs:**

- Incurred after a complete application is submitted;
- Purchase, installation, and/or retrofitting of fuel dispensers related equipment and infrastructure to support higher blend fuel sales;
- Construction, replacement, improvements;
- Fees construction permits, and licenses;
- Professional service fees.

#### **Ineligible Project Costs:**

- Renewable diesel projects;
- Sustainable aviation fuel projects;
- Used equipment and vehicles;
- Construction or equipment costs that would be incurred regardless of the HBIIP project;
- Purchase of real property/land or lease payments;
- Expenses associated with applying for, reporting, reimbursement, and servicing of HBIIP.

## HBIIP Overview (continued<sub>2</sub>)

There is a **Matching Funds** (cost sharing) requirement. Matching funds will need to cover the remaining balance that grant funds do not.

- Arrangements with private entities
- Commercial vendors of fuels
- Agricultural commodity/renewable fuel promotional organizations
- State-led programs and private sector efforts

## HBIIP Overview (continued<sub>3</sub>)

### **Matching Funds:**

- Required to receive HBIIP grant
- Remainder All eligible project costs not covered by Grant funds
- Consist of CASH and In-kind contributions
- Secured by applicant <u>must</u> have written commitments, such as bank statements for cash or Letters of Commitment for in-kind contributions
- In-kind from applicants is not eligible
- Other Federal grants are not eligible
- Passive tax equity contributions allowed

## **Build America, Buy America Act (BABAA)**

- If applying as:
  - State or Local Government
  - Indian Tribe
  - Institution of Higher Education
  - Nonprofit



- "Register Your Entity" with the System for Award Management (SAM) at <a href="www.sam.gov">www.sam.gov</a> to obtain a Unique Entity Identifier (UEI) and expiration date.
  - Make sure you complete the Certifications and Representations section when registering your entity.




- Create a USDA eAuthentication Customer Account, https://www.eauth.usda.gov.
  - Level 2 (verified identity) access is required.

- Create a Login.gov Account (tentatively available after July 24, 2023), <a href="https://login.gov/">https://login.gov/</a>.
  - Verified Identity will be required.





completing surveys online, and checking the status of USDA accounts.




## Obtaining access to the Online Application System

  - Begin Accepting Preliminary Environmental Information Surveys

- HBIIP Application Windows Closes at 4:30 pm Eastern on the final day of each quarter
  - 1. July 1, 2023 to September 30, 2023
  - 2. October 1, 2023 to December 31, 2023
  - 3. January 1, 2024 to March 31, 2024
  - 4. April 1, 2024 to June 30, 2024
  - 5. July 1, 2024 to September 30, 2024

## What's next? (Continued)

- Reviews expected to take 90-180 days from the date an application window closes
  - Agency Review for Eligibility and Completeness
  - Evaluation Panel and Competition
- Following Reviews
  - Selection, Written Communication to All Participants
  - Public Announcement of Obligations
  - Grant Agreement Execution
  - Project Completion/Reimbursement

## Additional Opportunities (continued)

- Rural Energy for America Program (REAP)
  - Provides financial assistance to agricultural producers and rural small businesses to make energy efficiency improvements or to install renewable energy systems
  - Types of funding
    - Guaranteed loans
      - Covers up to 75% of the eligible project costs for up to \$25 million
    - Grants
      - Covers up to 50% of the eligible project costs
      - For energy efficiency improvements, there is a \$1,500 minimum and \$500,000 maximum
      - For renewable energy systems, there is a \$2,500 minimum and a \$1,000,000 maximum
  - Eligible applicants
    - Small business is eligible rural areas
    - Agricultural producers with more than 50% of their income coming from agricultural operations

## Additional Opportunities (continued<sub>2</sub>)

Rural Energy for America Program (REAP) (continued)

### Examples

- Energy Efficiency Improvements
  - Refrigeration/Freezer upgrades
  - Commercial kitchen, food prep equipment upgrades
  - Lighting upgrades
  - Heating and Ventilation (HVAC) systems
- Renewable Energy Systems
  - Solar Array
  - Ethanol/Biodiesel Plant Retrofit

## Additional Opportunities (continued<sub>3</sub>)

- Business & Industry (B&I) Guaranteed Loans
  - Provides financial assistance to rural businesses for things like business expansion, purchase of machinery and equipment, debt refinance, etc.
  - Types of funding
    - Guaranteed loans for up to \$25 million
  - Eligible applicants
    - Businesses located in rural areas (population of 50,000 or less)
