velopment investment will be used to equip one hub/end-user site and three end-user sites in nty in central Illinois with telehealth equipment. Medical professionals at Carle Eureka Hospital bis will deliver specialty and critical health care services to individuals at three rural clinics estimated 10,011 rural residents.

velopment investment will be used to equip a mobile unit with telehealth and diagnostic e mobile unit will initially serve rural residents in Adams, Pike, Brown, Scott and Hancock ois and Marion county in Missouri. This mobile unit will be supported by six hub sites from ital, Illini Hospital, and Springfield Maternal Fetal Medicine. Once fully established the mobile t all of the Blessing Health System serving areas in Illinois and Missouri benefitting 200,247 individuals.
