## Dashboard Purposes

The Rural Investments by Industry Dashboards allow you to explore, filter, and display USDA Rural Development (RD) investments across industry sectors, states and counties, and congressional districts. You can also download datasets for analysis.

**NOTE:** The dashboards offer desktop and mobile device-optimized layouts. This guide refers to the desktop version.

## Context of Industry Classification

These dashboards analyze USDA RD investment data using the North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) – the standard used by federal statistical agencies to classify businesses and collect, analyze, and publish statistical data related to the U.S. business economy.

# How To Navigate the Data Pages

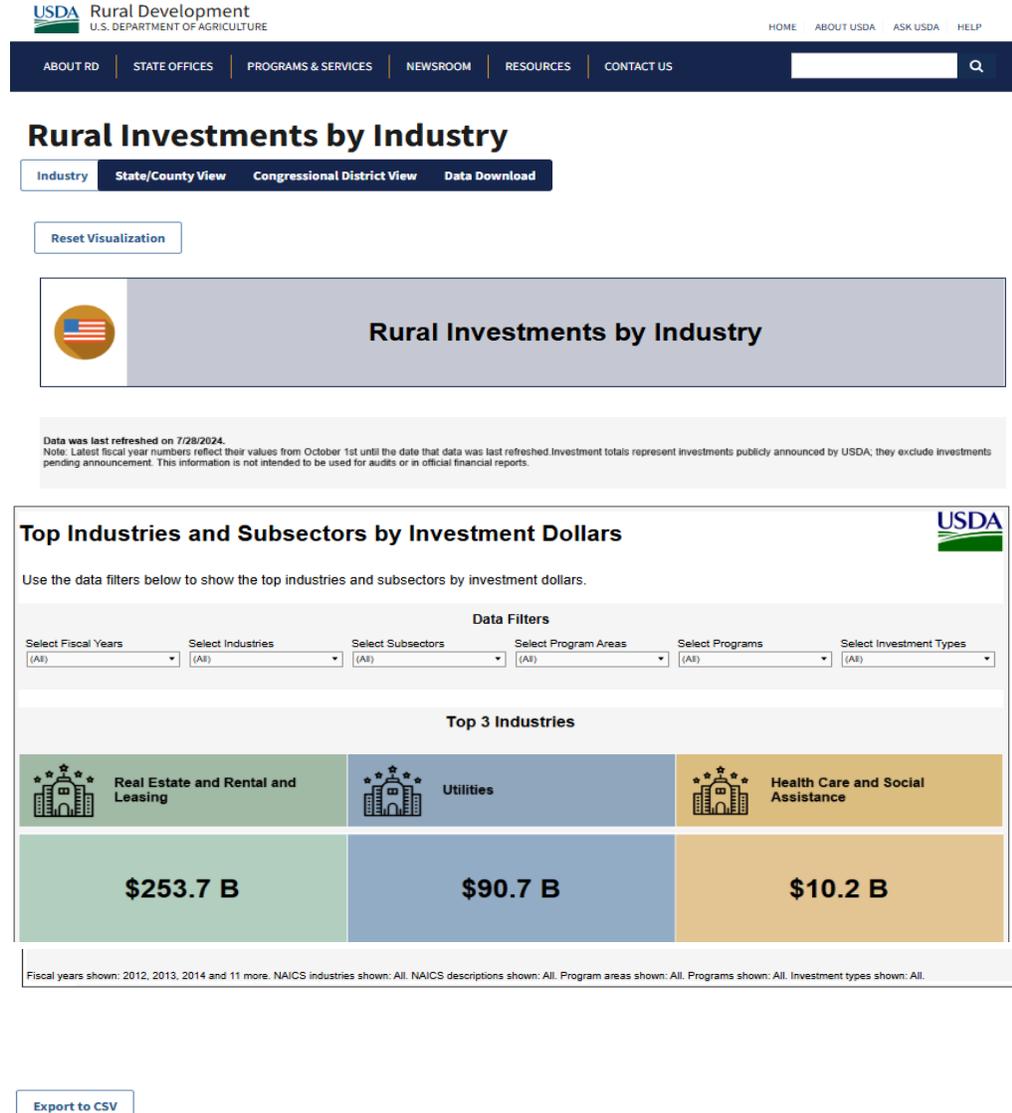


Figure 1: A screen shot of the Rural Investments by Industry dashboard.

**Navigation Menu:** Click on the topic you would like to explore. Each link pulls up a series of charts with options to filter, highlight, and download your data selections (see Figure 1).

**Reset Visualization Button:** You can use this button to reset the dashboard and remove filters (see Figure 1).

**Data Filters:** Narrow down data by selecting categories using the dropdown or slider filters. Click “Apply” for your selections to take effect. Click the dropdown menu again to close it (see Figure 1).

**Tooltips:** Helpful information is nested within the visualizations. Hover over the bars, hexagons, tiles, and numbers to view the details (see Figure 1).

**Footnotes:** At the end of the page, you can see when the data was last updated. Other important notes are also featured here (see Figure 1).

**Export to CSV Button:** At the end of the page, you can click this button to download your selected dataset (see Figure 1).

**Color Legends and Gradients:** When gradients of color appear on maps or in bar charts, the darker color or hue represents a higher number of investment dollars, while the lighter color or hue reflects lower investment dollar amount.

**Fiscal Year:** The fiscal year (FY) referenced on all dashboards starts on October 1 and ends September 30 of the following year.

## Available Dashboard Views

Dashboard View Name	Description
Industry	Shows investments in the top industries and subsectors and tracks investments over time (FY2012-current)
State and County View	Shows investments by state and county within NAICS industries, and provides a ranking of top investments
Congressional District View	Shows investments by congressional district within NAICS industries. Territories are not included in this view.
Data Download	Provides easy export of datasets

## Industry

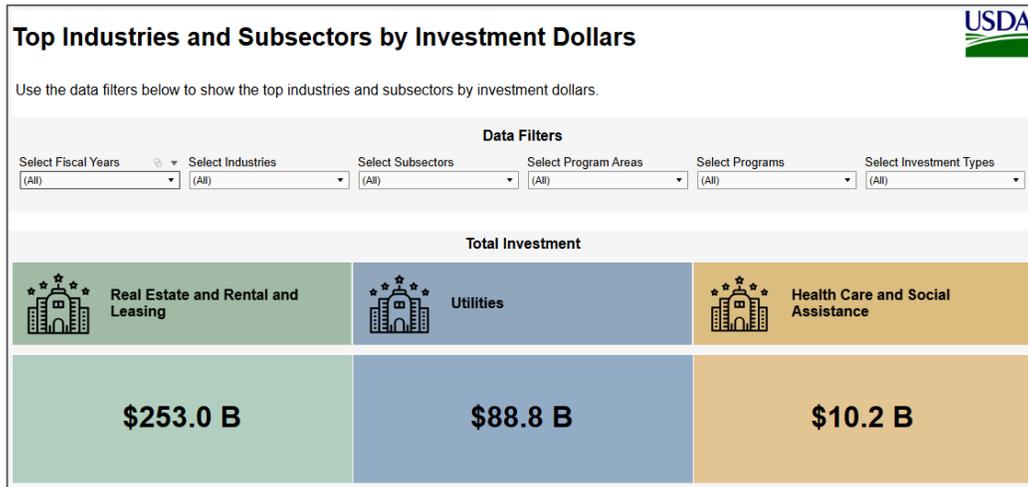
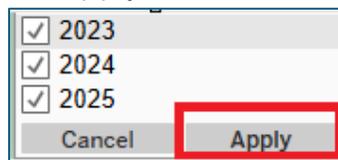


Figure 2: Screenshot of Industry Dashboard and its Data Filters

- You can interact with this dashboard using the filters in the Data Filters pane (gray box) along the top of the dashboard. Selecting a filter (for example, “Industries,” or “Fiscal Years”) will update the visuals on this page to match your selections.
  - To filter the dashboard data, click the down arrow on the desired filter, check or uncheck the values you wish to display or exclude and then click the Apply button.



- Click the down arrow again to close the filter options.
- The Industry Investment by Fiscal Year highlights which Fiscal Years you selected in the filter.

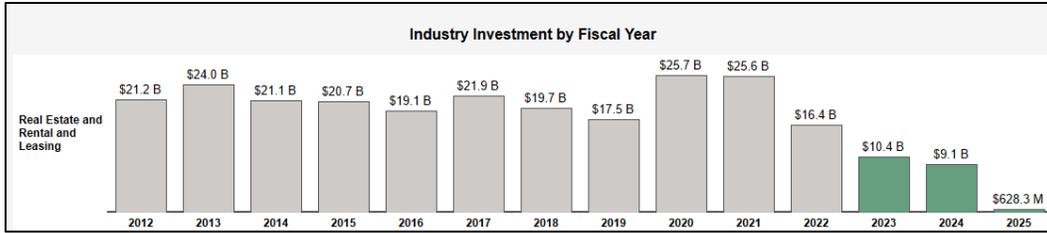


Figure 3: Screenshot of Industry Investments by Fiscal Year

- On the NAICS Ranking by Investment visual, you can view the industry or its subsectors using the filter in the green panel in the Data Filters Chart Layout box. This filter changes the chart layout between the NAICS industry and NAICS subsector.

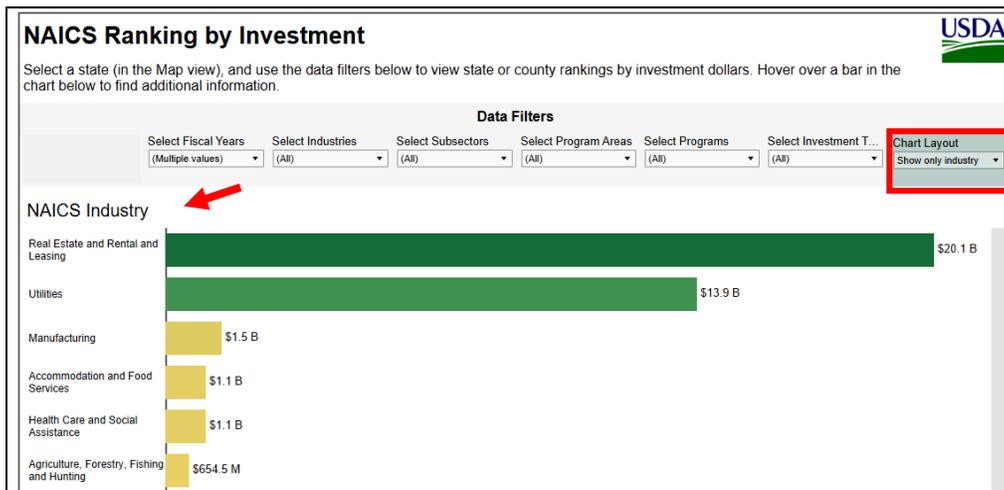


Figure 4: Screenshot of NAICS Ranking by Investment with Chart Layout “Show Industry Only” selected

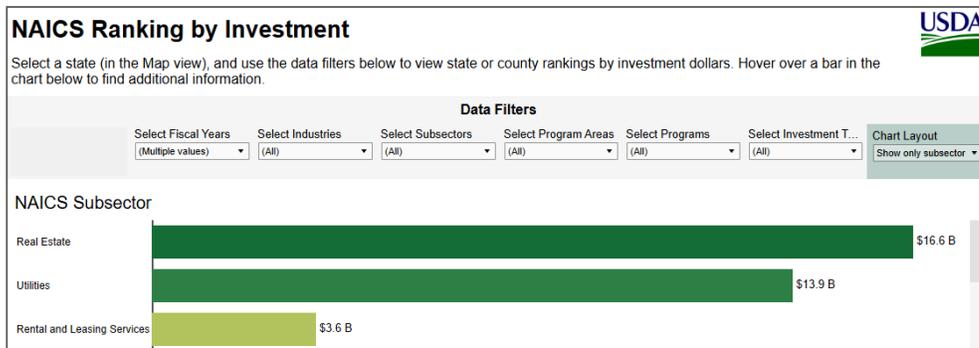


Figure 5: Screenshot of NAICS Ranking by Investment with Chart Layout “Show only subsectors” selected.



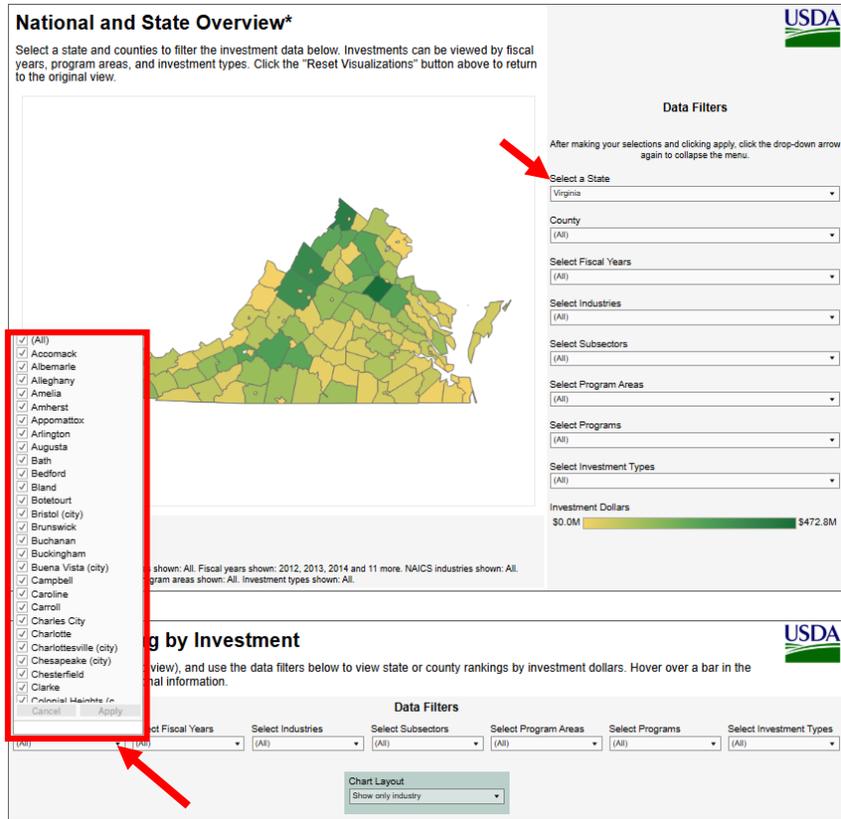


Figure 7: Screenshot of National and State Overview Dashboard County Map and Data Filter box

## Congressional District View

- You can interact with this dashboard using the filters in the Data Filters pane (gray box) along the right margin of the dashboard. Selecting a filter (such as “Industries” or “Fiscal Years”) updates the visuals to reflect your selection.
- Choosing a state in the “Select a State” filter updates the map to the congressional district level.

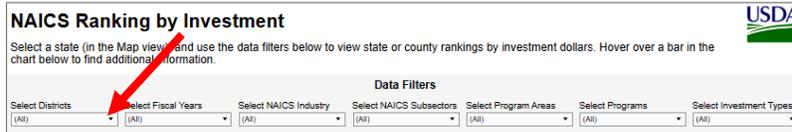
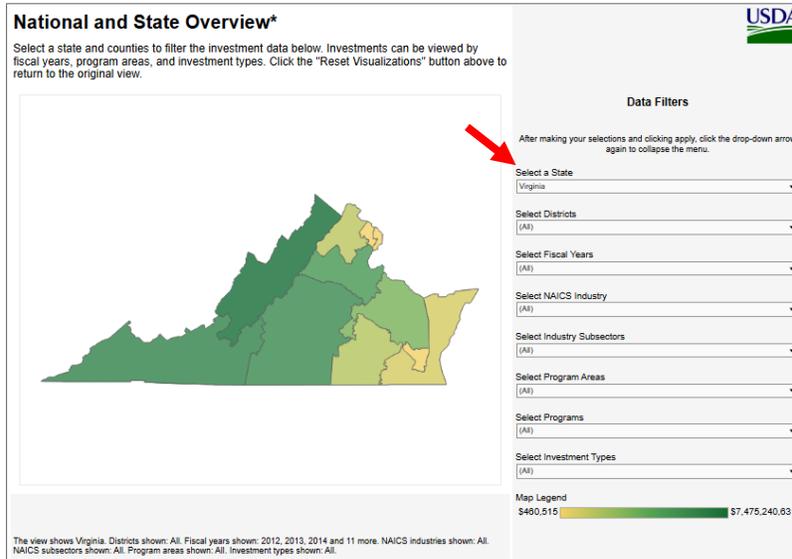


Figure 8: Screenshot of the National and State Overview, Congressional Map and Data Filter box

  - State selection updates the visuals for NAICS Ranking by Investment (see figure 8). Only congressional districts in the selected state are available in the “Select Districts” filter.

Industry	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• What are the top three industries for USDA Rural Development investments? What are the top subsectors?</li> <li>• In which year was the USDA RD investment highest in the top three industries since 2012?</li> </ul>
State and County View	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• In fiscal year 2022, in which state or county was the dollar amount of investments in the agriculture, forestry, fishing, and hunting industries highest or lowest?</li> <li>• In which county was the total dollar amount of guaranteed loan funds the highest from 2012 to 2022?</li> <li>• Which industry subsectors have the highest USDA RD investments in my county this year?</li> </ul>
Congressional District View	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• What district in my state has the highest or lowest investment dollars for the construction industry in 2021?</li> <li>• Which industries in my district received USDA RD investments?</li> <li>• What types of investments were they?</li> <li>• Which industry subsectors have the highest USDA RD investments in my district this year?</li> </ul>
Data Download	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• I want to analyze the data in Excel on my own.</li> </ul>
