ReConnect Program

What does this program do?

ReConnect provides loans,
grants, and loan-grant
combinations to bring
high-speed internet to rural
areas that lack sufficient access.

Funds can be used to build, improve, or acquire facilities and equipment needed for high-speed internet service.

We also encourage privatesector investments in broadband infrastructure to get high-speed internet service to rural homes, businesses, and essential community facilities that support public safety, health care, schools, libraries, business and industry, and agricultural operations.

Who can apply?

Eligible applicants include:

- · Cooperatives or mutual associations
- Corporations, limited liability companies, or limited liability partnerships
- State, local, and Tribal governments, and their affiliated organizations
- A U.S. territory or possession

What is an eligible area?

To be eligible, an area must meet two criteria:

- 1. The area must be rural.
- Ninety percent of households must lack sufficient access to broadband service.

What is considered "rural?"

Service areas cannot be located in cities, towns, or incorporated areas with populations greater than 20,000, or in urbanized areas adjacent cities or towns with populations greater than 50,000.

How can funds be used?

ReConnect funding can be used to:

 Build or improve facilities capable of delivering broadband service to every premises in the PFSA at the same time

- Purchase an existing system that does not currently provide sufficient broadband access
- Offset portions of approved pre-application expenses, including environmental reviews
