SUBJECT: Strategic Economic and Community Development (SECD) Field Instructions for

Fiscal Year 2020

PURPOSE/INTENDED OUTCOME:

This document outlines the process for FY2020 scoring and review of Strategic Economic and Community Development (SECD) applications. This process applies only to applications for Rural Business Development Grant (RBDG), Business & Industry (B&I), Community Facilities (CF), and Water and Environmental (WEP) programs that specifically request consideration under SECD. To be considered for SECD, all applications must include Form RD 1980-88, "Strategic Economic and Community Development (Section 6025) Priority," and supporting documentation. Reviewers will use a standard SECD Score sheet.

COMPARISON WITH PREVIOUS AN:

This is a new issue. There are no previous ANs.

BACKGROUND:

Section 6025 of the 2014 Farm Bill enables Rural Development (RD) to prioritize projects that support the implementation of multi-jurisdictional strategic economic and community development plans, either through priority points or a time-limited set-aside of up to 10 percent of program funds from certain RD programs.

Section 6401 of the 2018 Farm Bill re-authorized this provision with some modifications. The agency is in the process of issuing a new regulation to implement Section 6401 of the Farm Bill in FY 2021. Until the new regulation is implemented, RD will use the current regulation under 7 CFR 1980.1004 to administer SECD in FY 2020.

EXPIRATION DATE: September 30, 2020

FILING INSTRUCTIONS: RD Instruction 1980-K

For FY 2020, RD will set aside funds from the following programs: RBDG, B&I, CF, and WEP. SECD applications (Form 1980-88) are due by the underlying program deadline or 5:00 PM (EST) on June 30, 2020, whichever comes first.

All SECD applications will be scored and reviewed as noted in Table 1 below.

IMPLEMENTATION RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Applicants who have proposed eligible projects for RBDG, B&I, CF, and/or WEP that support multi-jurisdictional plans can request the opportunity for SECD set aside funding by submitting Form 1980-88 and other required information in RD Instruction 1980-K, "Strategic Economic and Community Development." Innovation Center staff will assess the packages for completeness.
- 2. Field Offices will review all underlying program applications for eligibility and score in accordance with the underlying program's regulations and instructions.
- 3. Field Offices will save all SECD applications to the SECD SharePoint site in the folder named for the underlying program. The SECD SharePoint can be found at: https://usdagcc.sharepoint.com/sites/rd_ic/SECD.
- 4. SECD National Coordinator will assign an Innovation Center staff member as Primary Reviewer.
- 5. All complete SECD applications will be reviewed, scored and returned to the National Coordinator and shared with the underlying program official within three (3) business days of uploading of the application to the SECD SharePoint.
- 6. The Primary Reviewer will use the SECD Scoresheet to document, review, score the application, share additional comments as needed and return to SECD National Coordinator.
- 7. SECD National Coordinator will confirm the SECD score and share the completed application Score Sheet with the underlying program approval official.
- 8. The SECD score must be written on the bottom of the SECD Scoresheet. The Primary Reviewer and SECD National Coordinator must sign and date the SECD Scoresheet as recommending officials for the awarded SECD points.
- 9. The program approval official will combine the underlying program score and SECD score in determining a recommendation for final awarding of program funds.
- 10. The final decision for awarding program funds from the SECD allocation will be made by the respective National Office Program Director or State Program Director, depending on the level of funding allocation and approval authority.
- 11. When recording award, information should be entered in Guaranteed Loan System (GLS) or Commercial Program Application Processing (CPAP) using the appropriate Type of Assistance (TOA) codes in Appendix A.

12. National Office will follow the National Office competition review-award-announcement-process, per usual procedures. Obligations must be made prior to June 30, 2020.
